### **CAMP PROGRAMS**

#### **FLEDGLING CAMPERS**

Fledgling Campers are 4 and 5 years old. They attend a fun filled ½ day from 9 until noon, with children their own age. Their story, game, craft, activities and explorations focus on one aspect of nature each day so each new day brings a new discovery. Fledglings bring their own mid morning snack and leave before lunch at noon.

#### **EXPLORER CAMPERS**

Explorers are 6 through 13 years of age and attend camp for a full day of activities from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. During nature activities, they will enjoy the camaraderie of a small group of friends their own age. Lunch, special activities, sharing and recreation time will be enjoyed with all the camp Explorers. An Explorer's day will be fun, full and active hiking, exploring, discovering and doing fascinating things throughout Capen Hill's 72- acre sanctuary.

#### **JUNIOR COUNSELOR PROGRAM**

The Junior Counsel Program is designed for teens 14 years and older. It is a great opportunity for

volunteer service if you are ready to start taking on adult responsibilities and acquiring leadership skills. Junior Counselors will assist naturalists with the children's programs, help lead recreation and learn the fine art of being an instructor. During this program, Junior Counselors enjoy exploring along with the children and lead counselors, but also have the responsibility of an assistant. It is necessary to attend a Junior Counselor training program before camp starts.

#### **PARENT WEEKLY VOLUNTEERS**

#### **REGISTRATION AND IMMUNIZATION RECORD REQUIREMENTS**

**The Registration Form** is on the reverse side of this brochure. One Registration Form must be completed for each child attending camp. Extra Registration Forms are available at Capen Hill's Visitor's Center which is open Monday-Friday 9-2. Saturday and Sunday, please call for hours. The form may also be downloaded from our website at www.capenhill.org. This form may be sent with or without the immunization record. **An Immunization Record** must be filled out through your child's physician's office and returned to us. A current school copy is also acceptable. Immunization records must be received a week before camp starts unless we are notified. Limited campers per session so register now!

## WHAT TO BRING

Fledglings bring drink and a snack in a labeled bag. Explorers bring drink, lunch and a snack in a labeled bag.

This is a nature camp. Most activities are outdoors though in very rainy weather campers are inside. Please dress child accordingly. Bug spray and sunscreen should be applied at home. Water bottle a must!
